

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Holiday Greetings from SWAT (Summer Winter Action Tours)!

We are looking forward to having your son/daughter on our next SWAT event in Utah, January 2-5, 2008.

In order to make this a safe and enjoyable trip for all involved we need you, the parents/guardians, to take an active role in guiding your child's participation. Please strongly reiterate the following rules of conduct to your child that were signed by you on the Behavior Code. There is a zero tolerance policy for any of the infractions listed below. Failure to comply will result in your child being removed from this adventure. You as Parent/Guardian will be required to come and pick up your child from Utah at your sole cost and expense, without subsequent refund. As expected, any other costs related to misbehavior will be the responsibility of you the Parent/Guardian.

- 1) No Alcohol or Drug use of any kind. SWAT maintains a zero tolerance policy. Parents should check ALL bags before they are loaded on the bus. Parents should also drop their students off to the pick up and check their bags again at the drop off before they load their bags on the bus.
- 2) No Fighting, stealing or vandalism of any kind. Again, SWAT maintains a zero tolerance for this type of behavior.
- 3) Students must be in their assigned room at 11:00PM and stay there for the rest of the evening.
- 4) No actions of any kind will be tolerated that jeopardize the safety, well-being and enjoyment of this vacation for other trip participants, staff or employees of SWAT, SWAT contracted buses, hotels or resorts. All students are expected to be respectful at all times to one another, as well as any other persons they encounter on this vacation.
- 5) You, the parents, are financially responsible for ALL actions of your child while they participate on a SWAT Adventure.

These rules must be taken seriously for the safety and benefit of all involved with this SWAT Adventure. If the above rules are not firmly adhered to there will be serious consequences, including, but not limited to disciplinary, monetary and/or legal actions from SWAT and the Salt Lake City Police Department. We are working together to insure a safe and sane vacation, and we need you, the parents, to be on our team! Thank you in advance for your assistance, we are looking forward to a great trip!
